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- 1. All Counselors are a part of the Biblical Lay Counseling Ministry and they may/may not have secular or professional training. They are spiritually mature and biblically knowledgeable.
- 2. All Counselors are to open and close every counseling session with prayer and are to refer to an open Bible during the counseling session.
- 3. The Counselors are not to discuss any counseling session with anyone who is not a Pastor without Pastoral permission.
- 4. Men are not permitted to counsel women one on one, and women are not permitted to counsel men one on one without Pastoral approval.
- 5. Biblical Counseling is a Ministry. There is no compensation for any type of Biblical Counseling. Any relationship that extends into the possibility of fees is to be clearly identified to the counselee and approved by the Pastoral Staff: for example, legal or accounting work)
- 6. All officially scheduled counseling is to be done at the Church building unless written Pastoral permission is granted.
- 7. By accepting counseling by the Biblical Lay Counseling Ministry, the Counselee agrees:
 - a) To commit himself/herself to the purpose of the counseling.
 - b) To be faithful to the scheduled time commitment. If 15 minutes have elapsed from scheduled appointment time without arrival of Counselee, the appointment will be canceled and may be rescheduled by the Counselee.
 - c) To be open and honest during the counseling sessions.
 - d) To be diligent in the completion of all homework and/or assignments.
 - e) To commit to a regular schedule of worship, Bible study, and prayer as agreed upon with the Counselor.
- 8. The counselee must notify the church or counselor 24 hours in advance to cancel an appointment.
- 9. The failure to adhere to the above commitments may result in the counseling relationship being terminated.
- 10. Any violations of the above policies will be reported to the overseer of the Biblical Lay Counseling Ministry.
